AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NARCOTIC DIVISION IN THE OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE NORFOLK DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 The district attorney of the Norfolk district is hereby
2 authorized and directed to establish a narcotics division
3 within his office, consisting of an investigating unit and
4 an educational unit, for the investigation of the illegal sale
5 and use of drugs and to inform the general public of the
6 district, relative to the use and abuse of narcotics, by the
7 distribution of appropriate literature, the showing of edu-
8 cational movies on the subject, the holding of seminars
9 and lectures by experts. He may appoint two special inves-
10 tigators, one for each of said units, who shall each be com-
11 pensated at an annual rate, to be determined by him with
12 the approval of the county commissioners, not in excess of
13 ten thousand dollars.
