AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE ELIGIBILITY OF TENANTS IN HOUSING PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Clause (f) of section 26FF of chapter 121 of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the sentence
3 inserted by section 4 of chapter 705 of the acts of 1966 and
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—As
5 between applicants equally in need and eligible for occupancy
6 of the dwelling and at the rent involved, preference shall be
7 given in the selection of tenants to persons displaced by public
8 action including enforcement of the minimum standards of
9 fitness for human habitation established by the state sanitary
10 code and other local ordinances, by-laws, rules or regula-
11 tions.

1 SECTION 2. Clause (g) of said section 26FF of said chapter
2 121, inserted by chapter 740 of the acts of 1965, is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word "action", in line 2, the
4 words:—, including the enforcement of the minimum stan-
5 dards of fitness for human habitation established by the state
6 sanitary code and other local ordinances, by-laws, rules or
7 regulations,.
