AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE TO MAKE RELOCATION PAYMENTS FOR MOVING COSTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 79
2 and 79A of the General Laws, in the event of acquisition of
3 land in the City of Cambridge by taking or by purchase, the
4 City of Cambridge is authorized in its absolute discretion to
5 make relocation payments for moving costs of individuals,
6 families and businesses displaced by the purchase or taking
7 of land in excess of the limitations contained in General Laws,
8 Chapter 79 and 79A.

1 SECTION 2. The City of Cambridge is authorized to pro-
2 vide by ordinance appropriate provisions for the definition of
3 moving costs, the limitations, if any, for relocation payments,
4 the procedure for making relocation payments and such
5 other matters related thereto.
