2 bers of the senate, five members of the house of representa-
3 tives and three persons to be appointed by the governor, is
4 hereby established for the purpose of making an investiga-
5 tion and study relative to the possibility of having hotels and
6 motels within the commonwealth establish reduced rates for
7 elderly persons.
