By Mr. Quinlan, a petition of John M. Quinlan for legislation relative to the registration fee for trailers used for non-commercial purposes. Public Safety.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION FEE FOR TRAILERS USED FOR NON-COMMERCIAL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 33 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 12 of chapter 679 of the acts of
3 1965, is hereby further amended by striking out subdivision
4 (5) and inserting in place thereof the following subdivision: —
5 (5) For the registration of every trailer for which a fee is not
6 otherwise provided in this section, six dollars for every one
7 thousand pounds or fraction thereof of the weight of such
8 trailer and the maximum load to be carried thereon; provided,
9 however, that the fee for the registration of a trailer used
10 wholly for non-commercial purposes shall be three dollars for
11 every one thousand pounds or fraction thereof of the weight
12 of such trailer and the maximum load to be carried thereon.”
