AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SUBSTANTIAL CURTAILING OF THE OPERATION OF ANY MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY STATION WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE CITY OR TOWN IN WHICH IT IS LOCATED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 161A of the General Laws as most re-
2 cently amended by section 1 of chapter 81 of the acts of 1967
3 is hereby further amended by adding after subsection (k) the
4 following subsection: —

5 (1) The authority shall not substantially curtail the opera-
6 tion of any station without the approval of the mayor and city
7 council of the city in which the said station is located, or in
8 the event the said station is located in a town, without the
9 approval of the board of selectmen.
