AN ACT RE-ESTABLISHING A RIGHT OF ACTION FOR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES WHERE A CHILD, A HUSBAND OR WIFE SUSTAIN A PERSONAL INJURY OR A PERSONAL INJURY RESULTING IN DEATH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 66 of Chapter 152 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended in the first line after the words "personal injury" by  
3 inserting the words "or consequential damages" so as to read  
4 in the first sentence: — In an action to recover damages for  
5 personal injury or consequential damages sustained within or  
6 without the commonwealth by an employee in the course of  
7 his employment or for death resulting from personal injury  
8 so sustained it shall not be a defense:
