AN ACT TO AMEND THE LABOR RELATING TO WOMEN AND CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. *Section 53* of Chapter 149 of the General Laws
