AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRUSTEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS TO ESTABLISH SALARIES OF THE OFFICERS AND MEMBERS OF THE MEDICAL SCHOOL OF THE UNIVERSITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 75 is hereby amended by striking out the first
2 sentence of Section 35 and inserting in place thereof the fol-
3 lowing sentence: — The trustees shall elect the dean and such
4 other officers and members of the professional staff of the
5 medical school as they deem necessary and shall fix their
6 classification, title and salary within the general salary sched-
7 ule, except that any such salary shall be fixed at any amount
8 not less than the minimum salary nor more than the maxi-
9 mum salary shown in the said schedule; provided, however,
10 that the trustees may establish the salary for the dean, heads
11 of departments and other members of the professional staff
12 occupying academic positions, without reference to the gen-
13 eral salary schedule and salary range.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TEACHERS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS TO RECEIVE THE SALARIES OF THE OFFICERS AND MEMBERS OF THE MEDICAL SCHOOL OF THE UNIVERSITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in and for the said Commonwealth, as follows:

1 Chapter 75 is hereby amended by striking out the first
 2 sentence of Section 55 and inserting in place thereof the fol-
 3 lowing sentence:—The trustees shall elect the dean and such
 4 other officers and members of the professional staff of the
 5 medical school as they deem necessary and shall fix their
 6 classification, title and salary within the general salary sched-
 7 ule except that any such salary shall be fixed at any amount
 8 not less than the minimum salary nor more than the maxi-
 9 mum salary shown in the said schedule; provided, however,
 10 that the trustees may establish the salary for the dean, heads
 11 of departments and other members of the professional staff
 12 occupying academic positions without reference to the gen-
 13 eral salary schedule and salary range.
