**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT PROVIDING SALARY INCREASES FOR CERTAIN TEACHERS AND PRINCIPALS IN RECOGNITION OF ADVANCED EDUCATIONAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Institution teachers, head teachers, and principals of the
- 2 Commonwealth, in recognition of their advanced educational
- 3 accomplishments, attainments and professional dedication
- 4 shall be granted increments as follows:
- 5 a) All teachers presently in job group classification 11 to be
- 6 placed in job group classification 14.
- 7 b) All teachers who have earned Master's degree and now
- 8 in job group classification 12 to be placed in job group classi-
- 9 fication 15.
- 10 c) Head teachers shall be placed in a single higher job group
- 11 classification at his appropriate degree level.
- 12 d) Principals shall be placed in the second higher job group
- 13 classification at his appropriate degree level.
