AN ACT PROVIDING FOR REGISTRATION OF VOTERS AT EVENING SESSIONS ON THE FIRST MONDAY OF EACH MONTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter fifty-one of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by inserting after section twenty-eight the following section: —

4 *Section 28A.* They shall hold a session until ten P.M. on the  
5 first Monday of every month at some suitable place in every  
6 city or town. If such first Monday of any month falls upon  
6 a legal holiday, said evening session shall be held on the following  
7 day.
