AN ACT REVISING THE ENABLING ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO LIMIT BUILDINGS ACCORDING TO THEIR USE OR CONSTRUCTION TO SPECIFIED DISTRICTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 665 of the Acts of 1956 is hereby amended by add-
2 ing at the end thereof the following: —

3 *Section 15.* Nothing in this act shall make valid any
4 ordinance which prohibits or limits the use of land for any
5 church or other religious purpose or for any educational pur-
6 pose which is religious, sectarian, denominational or public.
