AN ACT INCREASING THE MAXIMUM COMPENSATION PAYABLE TO CERTAIN CITY OFFICIALS FOR SERVICES AS MEMBERS OF RETIREMENT BOARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (4) of section 20 of chapter 32 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (c) and
3 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —
4 (c) The members of the board of any such city or town
5 system shall serve without compensation, but they shall be
6 reimbursed from the expense fund of such system for any ex-
7 pense or loss of salary or wages which they may incur through
8 service on such board. Nothing in this paragraph shall pre-
9 vent any city auditor, town accountant or other officer having
10 similar powers and duties, or any other person who serves
11 in the active administration of the system in lieu of the city
12 auditor, town accountant or other officer having similar powers
13 and duties, from being compensated for services rendered in
14 the active administration of the system; provided, that the
15 compensation for such services shall be not less than two
16 hundred nor more than fifteen hundred dollars per annum,
17 and shall be payable from the expense fund of the system.
