AN ACT RELATIVE TO COST-OF-LIVING INCREASES IN PENSIONS, RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES AND ANNUITIES PAYABLE TO CERTAIN RETIRED EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 661 of the acts of 1966, as
2 inserted by chapter 408 of the acts of 1967, is hereby amended
3 by striking out the sixth and eighth paragraphs thereof.

1 SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 661 of the acts of 1966,
2 as inserted by chapter 408 of the acts of 1967, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the third paragraph.

1 SECTION 3. Section 102 of chapter 32 of the General Laws,
2 as inserted by chapter 408 of the acts of 1967, is hereby
3 amended by striking out the second paragraph.
