AN ACT PROVIDING RETIREMENT CREDIT TO VETERANS EMPLOYED AS
POLICE OR FIREFIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provision of general or special law
- 2 to the contrary, credit for the number of years of active serv-
- 3 ice in the armed forces may be granted towards thirty years
- 4 retirement plan for police and firefighters in those towns
- 5 which vote to accept this provision.
