**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER  
OF AGRICULTURE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 5 of Chapter 20 of the General Laws as most recently  
2 amended by Section 42 of Chapter 801 of the Acts of 1963, is  
3 hereby amended by striking out said Section 5 and inserting the  
4 following section:—

5 The Assistant Commissioner shall receive such salary not ex-  
6 ceeding \$12,000, as the Governor may determine, and traveling  
7 expenses incurred in his official duties, and shall devote his  
8 full time during business hours to the duties of his office.
