AN ACT REQUIRING IN-SERVICE AND SUPERVISORY TRAINING FOR MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY POLICE OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 96B of Chapter 41 of the General Laws as most
- 2 recently amended by Chapter 742 of the Acts of 1968, is
- 3 hereby amended by striking the last paragraph and inserting
- 4 in place thereof the following new paragraph: —
- 5 Every regular police officer on a permanent full-time basis
- 6 in any such city or town, the metropolitan district commis-
- 7 sion police or the capitol police or the Massachusetts Bay
- 8 Transportation Authority police shall be assigned to and shall
- 9 attend a police training school approved by the municipal
- 10 police training council for the purpose of completing an ap-
- 11 proved course of study of inservice training at such intervals
- 12 and for such periods of time as the council may determine.
