AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A RAMP FROM THE GENERAL CASIMIR PULASKI SKYWAY TO FREEPORT STREET IN THE DORCHESTER DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF PUBLIC ROADS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 601 of the acts of 1961 is hereby amended by striking out in lines 2 and 3 the words, "subject to approval of the
