AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BERKSHIRE COUNTY TO USE THE POST-WAR REHABILITATION FUND FOR THE PURPOSE OF REMODELING, ALTERING OR RENOVATING THE BASEMENT OF THE COURT HOUSE OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF CENTRAL BERKSHIRE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1 The county commissioners of Berkshire county are hereby
2 authorized to sell the bonds held in the post-war rehabilitation
3 fund of said county, established under the provisions of chapter
4 five of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-three, and to use
5 the proceeds thereof to remodel, alter and renovate the base-
6 ment of the court house of the district court of central Berk-
7 shire for the purpose of providing suitable office space for
8 county offices.
