AN ACT INCREASING THE NUMBER OF SUPERVISORY POSITIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF CORPORATIONS AND TAXATION WHICH MAY BE EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

- 1 Section 106 of chapter 654 of the acts of 1953 is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out, in line 13, the word "seventeen", in-
- 3 serted by chapter 448 of the acts of 1966, and inserting in
- 4 place thereof the word: — eighteen.
