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AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE SALE AND DISTRIBUTION OF  
PESTICIDES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 13 of chapter 94B of the General Laws as most  
2 recently amended by chapter 75 of the acts of 1964, is hereby  
3 further amended striking out the last paragraph, paragraph  
4 (e) and inserting in place thereof the following new para-  
5 graphs:

6 (e) The director may revoke or modify any registration  
7 granted under provisions of this section if it is his finding that  
8 continuation of said registration as granted will constitute a  
9 hazard to the public health, fish, wildlife, shellfish, or other  
10 natural resources of the commonwealth. If such a finding is  
11 made, the director shall so notify the registrant(s) in writing  
12 of the effective date of the revocation of the registration(s)  
13 which date shall not be more than sixty days after the date of  
14 the letter of notification.

15 The findings on which said revocation is based shall  
16 constitute grounds for refusing to register identical, or sub-  
17 stantially similar formulations until such time as the director  
18 may, as the result of new evidence, reverse his findings.

19 (f) Notwithstanding any other provision of the pesticide  
20 law, registration is not required in the case of a pesticide  
21 shipped from one plant within this commonwealth to another  
22 plant within this commonwealth operated by the same  
23 person.
