AN ACT TO ESTIMATE THE COST OF LEGISLATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The house committee on ways and means and the senate
- 2 committee on ways and means shall, when reporting legisla-
- 3 tion indicate the estimated annual cost, if any, of such legisla-
- 4 tion.
- 5 Said estimate shall be printed in both the house and Senate
- 6 calendars on the day said legislation appears before the respec-
- 7 tive branch.
