In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION OF A CERTAIN QUESTION TO THE VOTERS OF THE COMMONWEALTH RELATIVE TO THE USE OF PUBLIC FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A SPORTS STADIUM IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state secretary shall cause to be placed on the official
2 ballot used in the cities and towns at the next biennial state
3 election the following question:—

4 “Shall the commonwealth use public funds to construct
5 and maintain a sports stadium in the common-
6 wealth?”

7 If a majority of the votes in answer to said question is in
8 the affirmative it shall be taken that the voters of the
9 commonwealth favor the use of public funds to construct and
10 maintain a sports stadium in the commonwealth. If a
11 majority of the votes in answer to said question is in the
12 negative, it shall be taken that the voters of the common-
13 wealth do not favor the use of public funds to construct and
14 maintain a sports stadium in the commonwealth.
