**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF CERTAIN DISABLED  
VETERANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 56 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out, in lines 12 and 13, the words "one  
3 per cent of said annual rate of compensation for each  
4 additional year of service, but not to exceed sixty-five" and  
5 inserting in place thereof the words:—one and one-half per  
6 cent of said annual rate of compensation for each additional  
7 year of service, but not to exceed seventy-two.
