AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXEMPTION FROM TAXATION OF REAL PROPERTY OF CERTAIN DISABLED VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (a) of clause Twenty-second of section 5 of chap-
2 ter 59 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out
3 the first sentence, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 666 of the
4 acts of 1962, and inserting in place thereof the following sen-
5 tence: — Soldiers and sailors who, as a result of disabilities con-
6 tracted or treated while in such war time service and in the line
7 of duty, have a disability rating of ten per cent or more as de-
8 termined by the Veterans Administration or by any branch of
9 the armed forces.
