### AN ACT RELATIVE TO TIRES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by add-
- 2 ing after section 7K the following section:—
- 3 *Section 7L.* No person shall sell, offer or expose for sale, have
- 4 in his possession with intent to sell, or give away for use on any
- 5 motor vehicle, motorcycle, or trailer any tire which is a second,
- 6 retread, or recap unless such tire has a plainly visible identifying
- 7 mark on the tire. These marks shall be in raised one-inch red
- 8 letters and marked thus: R for recaps or retreads; S for seconds.
- 9 Whoever violates any provisions of this section shall be pun-
- 10 ished by a fine of not more than fifty dollars.
