

HOUSE No. 767

By Mr. Fallon of Clinton, petition of Thomas F. Fallon and Joseph D. Ward for the appointment of two additional court officers for the Second District Court of Eastern Worcester. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF TWO DISTRICT COURT OFFICERS FOR THE SECOND DISTRICT COURT OF EASTERN WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 62, as most recently amended by chapter 764
3 of the acts of 1968, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section:—

5 *Section 62.* In the municipal court of the city of Boston the
6 court officers appointed shall not exceed ten for criminal busi-
7 ness, one of whom shall be designated by the chief justice as
8 chief court officer of said court for criminal business and one as
9 an assistant chief court officer, nor five for civil business, one of
10 whom shall be designated by said chief justice as chief court
11 officer of said court for civil business; in the municipal court of
12 the Roxbury district eight court officers may be appointed; in
13 the municipal court of the Dorchester district seven court
14 officers may be appointed, of whom one shall be designated by
15 the justice of said court as chief court officer and one assistant
16 chief court officer; in the third district court of eastern Middle-
17 sex and in the central district court of Worcester five court
18 officers may be appointed; in the second district court of
19 eastern Worcester two court officers may be appointed; in
20 the district court of Springfield four court officers may be
21 appointed; in the municipal court of the West Roxbury district,
22 in the district court of Somerville, in the district court of East

23 Norfolk, in the East Boston district court, and in the fourth
 24 district court of eastern Middlesex three court officers may be
 25 appointed; in the third district court of Bristol, in the municipal
 26 court of the South Boston district, of the Charlestown district,
 27 the district court of Chelsea, the first district court of eastern
 28 Middlesex, the second district court of eastern Middlesex, the
 29 district court of Newton and the district court of northern
 30 Norfolk two court officers for each court may be appointed;
 31 and in each of the other district courts in the commonwealth
 32 one court officer may be appointed.
