The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT REQUIRING ALL MOTOR VEHICLES ENGAGED IN ANY COMPETITIVE RACE TO BE EQUIPPED WITH A MUFFLER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 7L the following section:—
- 3 *Section 7M.* No motor vehicle shall be operated in any
- 4 competitive race unless it is equipped with a muffler of a type
- 5 approved by the registrar.
