AN ACT TRANSFERRING JURISDICTION OF THE TOWN OF SUTTON FROM THE DISTRICT COURT OF CENTRAL WORCESTER TO THE SECOND DISTRICT COURT OF SOUTHERN WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1 Section 1 of chapter 218 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the first paragraph under the
3 caption *Worcester*, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition,
4 and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:—

5 The central district court of Worcester held at Worcester;
6 Worcester, Auburn, Leicester, Paxton, West Boylston, Holden,
7 Shrewsbury, Rutland, Barre, Princeton, Oakham and Millbury.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 1 of said chapter 218 is hereby
2 further amended by striking out the sixth paragraph under
3 the caption *Worcester*, as so appearing, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following paragraph:—

5 The second district court of Southern Worcester, held at
6 Blackstone and Uxbridge, and at Northbridge in that part
7 thereof called Whitinsville; Blackstone, Uxbridge, Douglas,
8 Northbridge, Millville and Sutton.
