RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE NEED OF CONTROLLING THE CONSTRUCTION OF HOSPITALS.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two
2 members of the senate, three members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, the commissioner of public health and five persons
4 to be appointed by the governor, is hereby established to make
5 an investigation of the need of controlling the number, quality
6 and design of hospitals which may be constructed in the com-
7 monwealth.
