**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

AN ACT DESIGNATING CERTAIN DAYS AS LEGAL HOLIDAYS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking out clause eighteenth, as most  
3 recently amended by section 1 of chapter 24 of the acts of  
4 1968, and inserting in place thereof the following clause:—

5 Eighteenth, "Legal holiday" shall include January first,  
6 April nineteenth, July fourth, and Christmas day, or the day  
7 following when any of the said days occurs on Sunday, and  
8 the third Monday in February, the last Monday in May, the  
9 first Monday in September, the second Monday in October, the  
10 fourth Monday in October and Thanksgiving Day.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 136 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out section 13, as most recently amended  
3 by section 4 of said chapter 24, and inserting in place thereof  
4 the following section:—

5 *Section 13.* The provisions of section five to eleven inclusive,  
6 shall, except as provided in section fourteen, apply to all legal  
7 holidays, except the third Monday in February, March seven-  
8 teenth, April nineteenth, and June seventeenth or the day  
9 following when any of said days occur on Sunday.

1 SECTION 3. The effective date of this act shall be January  
2 first, nineteen hundred and seventy-one.

**The Government of Singapore**

**In the Year One thousand nine hundred and twenty.**

**An Act to amend the Public Holidays Act, 1919.**

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Council assembled, and by the authority of the State, as follows:

1. Section 4, Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out clause eighteenth as now existing amended by Section 4 of chapter 24 of the acts of 1919 and inserting in place thereof the following clause—
2. "The public holiday" shall in this section be that day which is the first day of the week following the day on which the public holiday in Singapore, the first Monday in May, the first Monday in September, the second Monday in October, the first Monday in October and Thanksgiving Day.

1. Section 5, Chapter 104 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 13 as now existing amended by section 4 of chapter 24 and inserting in place thereof the following section—
2. "Section 13 of the provisions of section five in clause eighteenth as now existing in section fourteen of chapter 24 of the acts of 1919 shall apply as provided in section fourteen of chapter 24 of the acts of 1919, in Singapore, Malacca and Penang, and also in the territories under the administration of the Government of this State on the day on which this day occurs on Sunday.

1. Section 6. The effective date of this act shall be January 1, 1920.
