## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy.

### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR SALARY FLEXIBILITY FOR THE MASSACHUSETTS ADVISORY COUNCIL ON EDUCATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of any general or special law  
2 to the contrary notwithstanding, the Massachusetts advisory  
3 council on education shall be permitted flexibility in providing  
4 compensation for its employees.

1 SECTION 2. Flexibility shall be defined as the council's  
2 authority to provide salaries for its employees and prospective  
3 employees at any level within the job group classification  
4 necessary to attract personnel to staff said council.
