AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALE OR TRANSFER OF CERTAIN PROPERTY BY THE BOSTON AND MAINE RAILROAD HERETOFORE REQUIRING THE PERMISSION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, the sale or
2 transfer of property by the Boston and Maine Railroad, here-
3 tofore requiring the permission of the Massachusetts Bay Trans-
4 portation Authority, shall be permitted only upon approval by
5 the general court.
