AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT AN ADDITIONAL WATER SUPPLY PIPE LINE IN THE CITY OF CHICOPEE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to construct an additional water
3 supply pipe line in the city of Chicopee comparable to the
4 present one now supplying water to said city.

1 SECTION 2. For the purpose of this act, said commission
2 may expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

EDUCATION OF THE DEAF

IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

For the purpose of providing for the education of the deaf in the District of Columbia, the following bill was introduced in the House of Representatives on July 1, 1903, and passed on July 1, 1903.

It is enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the following be and they are hereby enacted into law:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of the Interior is authorized to purchase, for the use of the Government, such land as may be necessary for the purpose of providing for the education of the deaf in the District of Columbia.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of the Interior is authorized to expend the sum of \$100,000 for the purpose of providing for the education of the deaf in the District of Columbia.
