AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SICK LEAVE RULES AND REGULATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of LS-1 of the sick leave rules and
2 regulations of the commonwealth is hereby amended by
3 striking out said first paragraph and inserting in place thereof
4 the following:—All persons, except emergency employees and
5 those persons exempted by Rule G-5, shall be credited with
6 sick leave with pay not to exceed two and one-half hours for
7 each week of service. Sick leave credit will begin at once for
8 persons starting work on a Sunday, otherwise on the first
9 Sunday following employment, and will accumulate each
10 week thereafter.
