AN ACT TO ALLOW CREDIT UNDER CERTAIN CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT LAWS TO WILLIAM A. KEAN FOR SERVICE RENDERED TO THE UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 William A. Kean, a professor at the state college at Boston,
2 and a member of the state retirement system, shall be
3 entitled to creditable service in said system from September
4 first, nineteen hundred and forty-six to February fifth, nine-
5 teen hundred and fifty-two inclusive, during which time he
6 taught at the United States Military Academy; provided,
7 that the said William A. Kean shall, within three months of
8 the effective date of this act, deposit in the annuity savings
9 fund of the state retirement system such amount as the board
10 of retirement of such system may determine as being equal to
11 that which he would have paid into said fund had such period
12 of service been creditable service under the state retirement
13 system, with regular interest thereon.
