By Mr. Hogan of Everett, petition of William F. Powers (Commissioner of Public Safety) and William F. Hogan relative to examinations of operators of hoisting machinery and the licensing thereof. Public Safety.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO EXAMINATIONS OF OPERATORS OF HOISTING MACHINERY AND THE LICENSING THEREOF.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 65 of chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing
2 in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended by striking
3 out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the follow-
4 ing sentence:—He shall be examined only as to his ability to
5 use the particular machinery, whether internal combustion,
6 compressed air, electric engine or otherwise, which he desires
7 to operate, and the license shall be limited to that particular
8 kind of machinery; but if he so requests, the applicant may be
9 examined as to his proficiency in the various kinds of ma-
10 chinery used for hoisting, and indicated by the numbered
11 blocks on the application, and the license shall include those
12 kinds of machinery in respect to which he is found competent.

It is the duty of the Board of Health to issue orders for the removal of any person who is afflicted with any contagious disease, and to cause such person to be confined in a hospital or other place, and to see that such person is properly treated, and that the disease does not spread.

It is ordered by the Board of Health of the City of New York, that the following be and they are hereby appointed, viz: _____

Section 1. of Chapter 100 of the General Laws as appearing in the Revised Edition is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—The Board shall be authorized and empowered to purchase machinery, whether manual or mechanical, and also electric engines or other articles which are adapted to operate, and the license shall be limited to that machinery and machinery, but it shall be lawful for the applicant to be contained as to his property in the various kinds of machinery used for printing and bookbinding by the numbered bills on the application, and the license shall include those kinds of machinery in respect to which he is found competent.
