AN ACT TO AMEND THE "GOOD TIME LAW" IN MASSACHUSETTS CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Amending the "Good Time" law in Massachusetts correc-
2 tional institutions to that of: Good time shall be granted to
3 inmates of correctional institutions for active participation in
4 approved programs of rehabilitation for such inmate and that
5 all inmates be allowed to earn one day off their term of sen-
6 tence for each approved program of rehabilitation entered
7 and successfully completed so as to promote, generate and
8 enthuse each inmate to become a more productive citizen
9 when released into society.
