AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE TOURISM AND INDUSTRIAL PROMOTION FUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 11 of chapter 64G as inserted by chapter 14 of the
- 2 acts of 1966, is hereby amended by striking out paragraph (b)
- 3 and inserting a new paragraph:—
- 4 (b) One third thereof shall be credited to a separate fund
- 5 which shall be established and set up on the books of the com-
- 6 monwealth to be known as the Tourism and Industrial Pro-
- 7 motion Fund, and shall be used by the dapertment of commerce
- 8 and development solely for the development and promotion of
- 9 travel, vacation, recreation and other aspects of tourism with
- 10 the commonwealth and for the development and promotion of
- 11 the commonwealth as an area for the location and expansion
- 12 of industrial and commercial business activities. No part of
- 13 this fund shall be used for the payment of salaries.
