

HOUSE No. 1716

By Mr. Scalli of Boston, petition of Arthur P. Lewis that the Metropolitan District Commission be directed to provide parking facilities at the intersection of Charles Street and Cambridge Street in the Ward 5 district of the city of Boston. Urban Affairs.

AN ACT DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO PROVIDE PARKING FACILITIES NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF CHARLES STREET AND CAMBRIDGE STREET IN THE WARD FIVE DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission shall
2 make provision for a parking area near the intersection of
3 Charles street and Cambridge street in the ward five section
4 of the city of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. Such facilities will specifically allow for cus-
2 tomers patronizing local retail establishments to park free
3 of charge and be given reasonable time limitations for such;
4 and that such parking spaces so designated shall allow the
5 residents of the surrounding area to park free of charge over-
6 night upon the closing of such retail stores in the immediate
7 vicinity, which shall include all the retail merchant shops
8 along Charles street in the city.
