AN ACT DEFINING THE TERM INCOMPETENT PERSON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the definition entitled "Heavy
3 duty platform trailer" the following definition:—incompetent
4 person; a person lacking legal qualification, ability, or fitness
5 to operate motor vehicles or to hold certificate of motor
6 vehicle registration.
