AN ACT TO PROHIBIT STANDEES IN SCHOOL BUSES AND TO REQUIRE MONITORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out clause (2) of section 7B and sub-
3 stituting therefor the following clause:—

4 (2) Each school bus shall contain adequate seating accom-
5 modations for each passenger transported therein, and no
6 school child shall be allowed to stand in any school bus while
7 such bus is in motion.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting at the end of section 7B the following
3 sentence:—

4 (8) Each school bus shall carry as a passenger at least one
5 person, eighteen years of age or over, who shall assist in main-
6 tenance of order and safety.

AN ACT TO PROMOTE THE INTERESTS OF THE STATE IN THE MATTER OF THE COMMISSION OF THE STATE.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the State, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out clause (5) of section 772 and substituting therefor the following clause:—
(5) Each school has shall contain separate outside schools, and no school shall be allowed to stand in any school lot while in use for its purpose.

SECTION 2. Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting at the end of section 774 the following provisions:—
(1) Each school has shall carry as a primary or high school, and no school shall be allowed to stand in any school lot while in use for its purpose.

SECTION 3. Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 774 as inserted by chapter 773 of the acts of 1904.
