AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING THE PROVISIONS FOR STATE EMPLOYEES RELATIVE TO SKELETON FORCE DAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of general or
2 special law to the contrary, whenever his excellency the
3 governor declares a "Skeleton Force" day, any employee
4 of the commonwealth who is required to work on said
5 "Skeleton Force" day, in order to maintain proper operation
6 of the departments and agencies of the commonwealth, shall
7 be entitled to an additional day off in lieu of the "Skeleton
8 Force" day.

1 SECTION 2. The director of personnel and standardization
2 shall make rules and regulations, subject to the approval of
3 the commissioner of administration and finance to put this
4 act into effect.
