AN ACT REDUCING THE ASSESSMENT ON THE CITY OF BOSTON RELATIVE TO THE OPERATIONS OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter ninety-two of  
2 the General Laws or any other general or special law to the  
3 contrary, ten per cent of the dollar amount assessible to the  
4 cities and towns comprising the area served by the metropoli-  
5 tan district commission shall be deducted from the assess-  
6 ment to be made upon the city of Boston and a like amount  
7 shall be assessed upon and paid by the remaining said cities  
8 and towns.
