RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a moral obli-
2 gation of the commonwealth and subject to appropriation,
3 there be allowed and paid out of the state treasury to the
4 United States Steel Corporation the sum of one thousand five
5 hundred and seven dollars and eighty-seven cents for dam-
6 ages to its truck scale at its Worcester plant as a result of an
7 accident which occurred on February eighth, nineteen hun-
8 dred and sixty-seven, when a truck owned by the Worcester
9 Sand and Gravel Company, Inc. was brought by a registry
10 of motor vehicles inspector to the said Worcester plant for
11 weighing in accordance with section nineteen A of chapter
12 ninety of the General Laws and while being weighed the
13 truck broke the scale.
