AN ACT CHANGING A DEFINITION IN THE LAW RELATIVE TO THE
RETAIL INSTALMENT SALES OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Section 1 of chapter 255B of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the definition of "Retail buyer" or
3 "buyer" and inserting in place thereof the following defini-
4 tion:—"Retail buyer" or "buyer", a person who buys or agrees
5 to buy a motor vehicle from a retail seller for use primarily
6 for personal, family or household purposes and who executes
7 a retail instalment contract in connection therewith, or any
8 legal successor in interest to such person, notwithstanding
9 that he may have entered into one or more extension or re-
10 financing agreements.
