### AN ACT TO EXTEND THE PERIOD FOR FILING AN APPEAL TO THE BOARD OF REVIEW OF THE DIVISION OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 40 of chapter 151 A of the General Laws, as amended  
2 through section 17 of chapter 763 of the acts of 1951 is further  
3 amended by striking out the words "five days after receipt,  
4 but in no case more than seven days" and inserting in place  
5 thereof the words:—seventeen days, so that section forty will  
6 read as follows:—*Section 40.* A claimant or interested party  
7 may, within seventeen days after mailing to him of notice of  
8 the decision, file an application for a review of such decision  
9 by the board of review.
