### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE POSITIONS OF ASSOCIATE COMMISSIONERS OF EDUCATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 572 of the acts of 1965 is hereby  
2 amended by inserting in sub-section 1F, paragraph 2, line 3  
3 after the word "an" the words:—associate commissioner—and  
4 by changing the word "assistant" each time it appears there-  
5 after to the word:—associate.

To the House of Representatives of the United States of America, in Congress assembled, the following report of the Joint Committee on the Organization of the Executive Branch of the Government, created by the Act of August 1, 1947, is respectfully submitted.

### The Organization of the Executive Branch

in the Executive Branch of the Government

As a result of the study of the organization of the Executive Branch of the Government, the Joint Committee on the Organization of the Executive Branch of the Government has the honor to submit to the House of Representatives the following report.

The study was conducted by the Joint Committee on the Organization of the Executive Branch of the Government, which was created by the Act of August 1, 1947, and is composed of the following members:

1. Section 2 of chapter 573 of the acts of 1947 is hereby amended by inserting in subsection 1 the following: "The Secretary of the Executive Branch shall be the head of the Executive Branch and shall be elected by the House of Representatives for a term of four years, and shall be eligible for re-election for one term only."
2. After the word "and" in the second sentence of subsection 1 of section 2 of chapter 573 of the acts of 1947, the words "and the Secretary of the Executive Branch" shall be inserted.
3. For changing the word "Secretary" to "Secretary of the Executive Branch" in the second sentence of subsection 1 of section 2 of chapter 573 of the acts of 1947.
