By Mr. Rogers of New Bedford, petition of George Rogers for legislation to increase the minimum amount of construction grants for certain approved school projects in cities and towns. Education.

AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM AMOUNT OF CONSTRUCTION GRANTS FOR CERTAIN APPROVED SCHOOL PROJECTS IN CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of chapter 645 of the acts of 1942, is
2 hereby amended by striking out clause (a) as appearing in sec-
3 tion 1 of chapter 467 of the acts of 1963, and inserting in place
4 thereof the following clause:—

5 (a) The total construction grant for any approved school
6 project in any city or town shall be fifty per cent of the final
7 approved cost.

1 SECTION 2. The provisions of clause (a) of section 9 of
2 chapter 645 of the acts of 1948, as amended by section 1 of
3 this act, shall apply to projects approved by the board of
4 education prior to the effective date of this act, and which are
5 under construction but unoccupied on said date, and to proj-
6 ects so approved but construction of which has not commenced
7 prior to said date, and to all projects so approved on or after
8 said date.
