AN ACT PROVIDING AN INCREASED ALLOWANCE FOR EARNINGS OF A PERSON PENSIONED OR RETIRED FOR DISABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second sentence of the first paragraph of section 91A of
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most recently amended
3 by chapter 431 of the acts of 1966, is hereby further amended by
4 striking out, in line 6, the word "one" and inserting in place
5 thereof the word:— two.

The Constitution of the United States

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety

and Ninety-eight, the Constitution of the United States was amended by a
series of amendments, the first of which was adopted in 1791.

The amendments are contained in the Constitution as amended, and
are numbered in order of their adoption.

1. The second sentence of the first paragraph of article III of
chapter 84 of the General Laws, in which the words "and
by chapter 841 of the acts of 1890" are inserted, and changing in them
the word "and" to the word "or", and changing in them
the word "and" to the word "or".
